According to the book, "Remarks and Collections of Thomas Hearne, Volume 2," Oxford Historical Society, Clarendon Press, Oxford, England, 1885, p. 278, which recounted information from a letter of Joshua Barnes, son of Edward Barnes & Mary Mills, a Greek scholar at Cambridge, William Barnes was also a son of Edward, who would have been from the first marriage according to his birth date of 1640. The full entry reads "Mr. William Barnes, born at * * * 1640, Captain of the 1 Troop of Guards to K. Charles II. James II. & K. Wm. III. Queen Anne, met him at ye Rose at Cambridge, April 21, 1705. Din'd with him at ye same place, the next day, at his Invitation, 65 years old. A Son John Barnes."

Edward Barnes was said to have had eight children with his first wife, none of whom survived the Great Plague of London.

A child named Andrew Barnes, 6 months old, was buried 7 October 1643 at St. Botolph, Bishopsgate, London, England. No parents are named, so this child may or may not be a child of Edward Barnes and Alice Cock.

CHILD 7 - [Unknown] Barnes

Edward Barnes was said to have had eight children with his first wife, none of whom survived the Great Plague of London.

An unidentified infant Barnes, aged 6 months, was buried 30 Dec 1644 at St. Botolph Bishopsgate, according to the printed record, p. 76. This may be one of the children of Edward Barnes & Alice Cock.
