

Joseph Barnes & Selah DeLoach Timeline (including some of their children)

- c1744 **Perhaps Northampton Co., NC. Joseph Barnes** was born to **Jacob Barnes** and **Julian/Juland Whitley**.¹
- 16 Jan 1764 **Edgecombe Co., NC. Joseph** was named as a child of **Jacob Barnes** in his will.
- c1767/1769 **Edgecombe Co., NC. Joseph Barnes and Selah DeLoach** were married.
- Abt 1770 **Edgecombe Co.,NC. John Barnes** was born to Joseph Barnes & Selah/Celia DeLoach.
- 25 Jan 1771 **Edgecombe Co., NC. Joseph Barnes**, deed for 233 acres from **William Phillips**, Wit.: **Dempsey Dawson, James Phillips**.²
- 16 Jan 1772 **Edgecombe Co., NC. Joseph & Selah Barnes** to **William Bond**, 640 acres. Wit.: **William White, James Phillips**.³
- Abt 1772 **Edgecombe Co.,NC. Julan or Julian (Juliann) Barnes** was born to Joseph Barnes & Selah/Celia DeLoach.
- c1774 **Edgecombe Co., NC. Molly Barnes (also shown as Polly Barnes)** was born to Joseph Barnes & Selah DeLoach.
- c1777/1780 **Edgecombe Co.,NC. Celia Elizabeth Barnes** was born to Joseph Barnes & Selah DeLoach.
- c1780/1784 **Edgecombe Co., NC. William Barnes** born to **Joseph Barnes & Selah DeLoach**. Age estimate is based on the fact that William was under age when his father's will was written in 1794, and William was an adult in the 1805 tax records of Sumner Co., TN.
- c1782/1790 [1785] **Edgecombe Co., NC. Kinchen Barnes** was probably born in this county, as his parents did not come to Sumner Co., TN (according to deeds), until at least 1791/1792. **NOTE: I am going to place Kinchen's birth at about 1785**, taking into consideration his age in the 1820, 1840, 1850, and 1860 censuses. Information in the 1850 and 1860 censuses varies (c.1790 SC in 1850 census and c.1782 TN in 1860. He married in 1806, and I have subtracted age 21 from this.)
- c1786 **Edgecombe Co., NC. Milly Barnes** born to Joseph Barnes & Selah DeLoach.
- 15 Dec 1787 **Edgecombe Co., NC. Mary "Polly" Barnes** was born to Joseph Barnes & Selah DeLoach. NOTE: Molly was also called Polly, so there were two Pollys in the family. I am not sure that the 1787 one is correctly attributed to Joseph and Selah, but this information was accepted by a lineage society. I don't know what the documentation was.

- 1790 **Halifax District, Edgecombe Co., NC. Joseph Barnes**, 2 white males 16 or older, 3 white males under 16, 5 females of any age, 5 slaves.
- 10 Feb 1791 **Edgecombe Co., NC. Joseph and Selah Barnes** deed for 233 acres to **Jesse Barnes**. Wit.: **Dempsey Barnes, Priscilla Ezial** (perhaps Azial, Azial, etc.).⁴
- xx xxx 1792 **Sumner Co., TN. Joseph Barnes**, 440 acres from **Josiah Love**.⁵
- 20 Feb 1793 **Sumner Co., TN. Polly Barnes** married **Elijah Clary; Peter Looney**, bondsman.
- 1794 **Sumner Co., TN. Joseph Barnes** on tax list, line 18.
- 17 Aug 1794 **Edgecombe Co., NC. Joseph Barnes**, power of attorney to (cousin) **Ruffin DeLoach**. Wit.: **Wm. Faulk, Wm. Brasswell**.⁶
- 17 Dec 1794 **Sumner Co., TN. Joseph Barnes** made his will.⁷ Daughter **Molly Clay [Clary]**. Wife **Selah** to have plantation until son **William Barnes** is 21. Sons **John Barnes, Kintchen Barnes**. Daughters **Polly Barnes, Julian, Selah, Milly** under age. Execs: **Selah Barnes, John Barnes**. Wit.: **John DeLoach, William Cartwright, John Roberts**.
- 15 Apr 1795 **Sumner Co., TN. Will of Joseph Barnes** was registered with the court.⁸
- 27 Dec 1796 **Sumner Co., TN. John Barnes** married **Mary Turney; Elisha Clary**, bondsman.
- 17 Nov 1797 **Sumner Co., TN. Indenture, Henry Turney**, Hawkins Co., Tennessee, to **John Barnes**, \$300, 200 acres, part of preemp. of 640 acres on N side Cumberland River. Wit: **P Turney, Jurat, John Looney**.^{9,10}
- 1799 **Sumner Co., TN. Joseph Barnes** sold to **William King** 440 acres.¹¹
- 30 Oct 1800 **Sumner Co., TN. Celia Barns** married **Charnel Corbin**.
- 06 Jan 1801 **Sumner Co., TN. Deed Elisha Cleary** to **William Barnes**, in consideration of a bargain with **Joseph Barnes, now decd**, 100 acres on Turney's Creek where **Selah Barnes now lives**. Wit: **John Cleary, John Barnes**.¹²

- 01 Nov 1804 **Sumner Co., TN.** Deed **Elisha Cleary** [Clary], to **Jearrette Seatte**, \$200, tr of 50 acres, abutting land of **William Barnes**. Wit: **Butler Noles, Kinchen Barnes**.¹³
- 18 Dec 1804 **Sumner Co., TN.** **Polly Barnes** (attributed as daughter to Joseph and Selah) married **Henry Davis Allen**. Marriage not recorded in Sumner marriage book.
- 21 Sep 1805 **Sumner Co., TN.** **Ruffin DeLoach, Allin Purvis, Nickolas Boyce** were found to **Sheriff Thomas Martin** of Sumner Co. to appear at court to answer **John Barns** and **Celia Barns**, executor and executrix of the last will of **Joseph Barns**.¹⁴
- 1805 **Sumner Co., TN.** **William Barnes** is on the tax list.
1805 **Sumner Co., TN.** **William Barnes, Sr.**, is on the tax list. (Identity of the 2nd Wm not known.)
- 22 Jul 1806 **Sumner Co., TN.** **Kinchen Barnes** married **Elizabeth Braswell; Ruffin DeLoach**, bondsman.
- 06 Dec 1806 **Sumner Co., TN.** **John Barnes** to **Edward Sanders**, 200 acres, Book 4, p. 153.
- c1807 **Sumner Co. or Montgomery Co., TN.** **William Barnes and Sarah Sanderson** were married. No record found. Date is estimated and could be refined later.
- 1810 No Tennessee census survives for Sumner Co.
- 1817 **Sumner Co., TN.** **Elisha Clary**. Index to Estates, #215.¹⁵
- 1820 **Montgomery Co., TN.** Federal census (p. 30) shows **Kinchen Barnes**, age 26-45, born between 1775 and 1794, and wife of the same age bracket. Three boys and three girls born 1810-1820, one girl born 1804-1810. (Reps Barnes, p. 20; Patsey Barnes, p. 22. Unknown if related.)
- c1821/1826 **Kinchen Barnes** and his family moved from Tennessee to Alabama.
- c1827 **Alabama.** **Kinchen Barnes's** daughter **Matilda** was born.
- 1808/1829 **John Barnes** and **Mary Turney** came to Alabama sometime during this period.
- 30 Mar 1828 **Wilcox Co., AL.** **John Barnes's** son **Kinchen Barnes** married **Nancy Watson**.
- 1830 **Monroe Co., AL.** Federal census, p. 31, **John Barnes**, aged 50-59 (born 1771-1780). 1 m 10-14, 1 m 15-19, 2 males 20-29. 1 m 50-59; 1 f 20-29, 1 f 50-59. 3 slaves. (NARA Series: M19; Roll Number: 2.)

*The widowed Selah BARNES in the 1790 census is unidentified, but her family does not match that of Joseph Barnes of Edgecombe and Sumner counties.

**This Joseph Barnes is likely to be the Joseph Barnes described in this record. The number of daughters is the same as in the Sumner Co. will (5 females, of which 4 would be daughters). The will named 3 sons. One son could have died. It is possible that one could have received an earlier settlement before Joseph died, but this does not seem likely. A son could have been born about 1775 or later but who died before Joseph's will was made 17 Dec 1794.

1790 Joseph Barnes census shows:

2 males 16 or older: Joseph, John b c1768-aged 22

3 males under 16: Kinchen b 1782/1790; William b 1780/1785; and **one more, unidentified – could be a field hand**. 5 females of any age: Selah, Molly [married by Dec 1794], Polly, Julian, Selah Jr., Milly. Joseph's will stated that he had 7 children, but 8 are named.
