(She was always seen in those items of apparel, even in the house.) When I asked if anybody had pictures of her, I was told that she never wanted her picture taken. My Aunt Clara and Aunt Hazel (one in her 80's and the other in her 90's) say that Mariam was not a very social person. She preferred to spend time in the kitchen or out feeding the chickens, to socializing when their family visited. My aunts remember her sitting on the porch, smoking her corn cob pipe. Someone on that trip told us that she was a Mennonite, and attended either the Baptist or Mennonite Church." To this Dr. Welch added: "One of Mariam Cyempka's black sunbonnets is in the Thermopolis, WY, Museum with large pictures of Henry, son Addie, and Addie's wife, Katherine."

CHILD 7 - Marion Carroll Barnes

According to June Rayfield Welch of Dallas TX, now deceased, Marion Carroll Barnes was captured with his sister Mariam Cyempka Barnes by the Indians who killed his mother and two oldest siblings. He would never talk about living with the Indians or his rumored Indian ancestry. Although he lived in the Indian Territory, according to Dr. Welch, he refused to admit his Indian blood and receive a land allotment. (Dr. Welch and other researchers thought that John B. Waits may have married an American Indian. It is unclear whether it is true that Marion Carroll Barnes had Indian blood.)

He was ransomed and raised by John Hale, who may have been a relative. John Hale's Bible, New York: American Bible Society, 1867, shows a birth date for Marion of 8 May 1852. The Renner family Bible (his sister Mariam Cyempka married Henry Harrison Renner) and a 21 Jun 1911 postcard from Marion's wife gave his birthdate as 15 May 1852.

Marion Carroll Barnes and Sarah Ellen Stokes Timeline[1]
