HUSBAND - James Whiting Beall

Personal papers and notes of Aileen (Beall) Whaley of Sweetwater, TX, deceased.

The Peytons of Virginia, compiled by the Peyton Society of Virginia, 1976, p. 84, entry for Josiah Beall.

U.S. Census:

1870 Austin Co., TX, pct. 5, PO Industry, p. 105: James Beal, age 24, MS (born about 1846).

1880 Williams Co., TX, S.D. 5, E.D. 137, p. 9: Mary Beall (James's widow).

J.W. Beall's daughter Laura wrote in a 1957 letter that her father was buried in Dunnville Cemetery, Cooke Co., TX. No such cemetery is known today, but a researcher said Cooke Co. has many small cemeteries or unmarked burial places. Perhaps it was a cemetery owned by a Dunn family. There was a David Dunn on the 1880 census in the N.E. part of the county. [Researcher: Billye Howe, 200 E. Tennie, Gainesville, TX 76240] NOTE: for a short time around the 1870s or 1880s Grapevine in Tarrant Co., TX, was called Dunnville. It is possible that James W. Beall died in Cooke Co. but was buried in Grapevine because Bealls had lived in Grapevine. Grapevine Cemetery records do not show a grave for James W. Beall, but many early graves are not recorded, and their stones have disintegrated or been vandalized, leaving no clues about names and dates.

The only record of James in Cooke Co. is on the 1878 tax rolls, for 1wagon/carriage, 3 horses/mules, 6 cattle, 17 hogs, and 2 paid poll taxes. Location of residence was not noted on the rolls.

James Whiting or Whitten Beall is not on the 1880 Texas Mortality Schedule, which would list any death between 01 Jun 1879 to 01 Jun 1880. This means, if accurately reported, he did not die between 01 Jun and 31 Dec of 1879. Therefore, he is likely to have died between 01 Jan 1879 and 31 May 1879.

Date of second marriage, county, and dates of children's births from compact disc, "Vital Records Index for North America, produced by the LDS church, extraction of data from filmed county records.

WIFE - Martha F. Barnes

Listed as child in household of John S. BARNES, 1850 census, Cass Co., Texas, as Martha F. Barnes.

According to Dianne Doyle Stevens, a direct descendant of Martha's sister, Mary Elizabeth Barnes, Martha's middle name was Elvira. Dianne's source was notes her father, Richard J. Doyle, now deceased, made when talking to his grandmother, Marguerite, who was the daughter of Mary Elizabeth.

Martha was shown in the 1870 Federal Census of Austin Co., Texas, as wife of James BEALL. He remarried in Burnet Co., Texas, so Martha may have died in Austin Co. or Burnet Co. or a county adjoining one of these. It is possible she died in Tarrant Co., but this appears to be less likely.

If this record is for Judson, he lied about his age and was in error about his mother's birthplace (Texas).

1900 Indian Territory (Oklahoma), Choctaw Nation, E.D. 99, Sup.D. 73, Sheet 11, line 20/fam. 218, Twp 3 N/R 15 6, 18 Jun 1900: BEALL, John T. (he probably gave name as Jack, and census taker assumed that was a nickname for John), head of household, white male, born in Sept. 1866, age 33, married 11 years, born in TX, father born in MS, mother born in TX, farmer, could read, write, speak English, renter. Emma, wife, 4/4 children living (Suma, Adaline, Laura, Hallie).

Death certificate gives birth as 22 Sep 1864. 1866 is more likely to be accurate because that year is indicated by the 1870 and 1900 censuses.

Interview on Thursday, October 17, 1991, with Randolph Ballard of Sweetwater, Texas, a grandson of Judson Tatum Beall, nicknamed Jack and J.T.

Judson was orphaned, and his siblings were divided between two uncles' homes. He went with a sister to live with an uncle (does not know name of uncle; census indicates it was Henderson Barnes/if sister was Lillie). He was aged 12-14. He brought with him a number of hunting dogs, two pet sheep, and a pony. His uncle bought him a new suit and sent him to a picnic. While he was gone, his uncle shot and killed all the hunting dogs he'd brought with him. Judson's heart was broken. He gave the pet sheep to a neighbor girl, got on his pony, and rode away, never to return.

He was on his own after that, traveled around Texas a lot (not known if he left the state). Came to Sweetwater in the 1880s. Judson apparently knew of a couple of his cousins who came to Sweetwater and had an abstract and title business there. In Sweetwater he worked in a wagon yard and in 2 "Chinamen's" restaurant. Also worked for a cattle company till aged 18-19. Went back to Grapevine and stayed a short time, married Emma Rogers, a friend from childhood. Her folks were from England.

Judson returned to Sweetwater after a lot of travel around the state, during which time he had a farm for a year or so, then moved on. He "became famous" in the Sweetwater area and "employed lots of people." Owned property in Scurry, Fisher, and Jack counties -- Jack is west of Wise Co., which is west of Denton Co. He was called "J.T." in later years. Was a good violinist, spent much time playing. He was a storyteller, too.

CHILD 2 - James Edward "Ed" Beall

1870 Census, Austin Co., TX, Precinct 5, Industry Post Office, p. 105 (Nov. 4), 725/736: in household of James and Martha Beal: Beal, James, 3 M W, Texas.

March 4, 1876, through July Term, 1878, Denton County, TX, guardianship file for land inheritance: James E. Beall, Jas E. Beall are the names given for Ed. His father was appointed guardian for land in Tarrant Co., TX, one-fifth undivided interest in 70 acres out of the William Welsh Survey, known as Lot No. 8.

1880 Census, Tarrant Co., Texas, Supervisor's District 3, Enumeration District 92, page 14, 128/134 (June 9): in household of Walter D. Beall: Edward J., W M 12, Texas, listed as a son (although he was a nephew).

Laura Josephine (Beall) Smith, sister of Ed, wrote to Aileen Beall Whaley of Sweetwater, TX, on 18 June 1957 from her son's home in Morgantown, WV (Marion Judson Smith) that her parents, James Whiten [sic] Beall and Martha Barnes had 4 children: Jack, Eddie, Lilly, and Laura. She stated: "Ed lives at Boise City, Idaho. Has no children."

Research that Cecilie (Smith) Gaziano, granddaughter of Laura and daughter of Marion) had done in Idaho did not turn up a single record for James Edward Beall. The last sighting of him, according to Randolph Ballard, a grandson of Ed's brother Judson, was when Randolph was a boy, staying overnight with his grandparents and Ed stayed overnight, too. After Ed left the next day, Judson "Jack" told Randolph that the man was Jack's brother. Randolph was born in 1928. If his story is accurate about the man he saw being Ed, Ed was last seen around 1935/1945.

A search of the Social Security Death Index turned up no sign of James Edward Beall. Searches of the 1920 and 1930 Census Indexes were fruitless also, as were attempts to obtain a death certificate for Ed in Oregon (1941-1970), Washington (1940-1969), Oklahoma (1908-1977), Texas (1903-1966), Idaho (1911-1947, 1933-1968), or California (all years).

A marriage record in Idaho appears to be for Ed: Western States Marriage Records Index at www.familysearch.org shows Edward Beall and Ella C. Lile in Nampa, Canyon Co., Idaho, on 21 June 1902, Vol. 2, p. 161. Canyon County,

CHILD 3 - Laura Josephine Beall

1870 Austin Co., TX, pct. 5, PO Industry, p. 105: James Beal, age 24, wife Martha, shows Laura as an infant. Perhaps she was born in Austin County. Her son Marion's marriage license in Madison Co., Nebraska, stated that she was born in Travis Co., Texas. I believe, however, that this was in error, as some members of the family thought she was born in Austin, TX, when she was really born in Austin County, Texas.

1878 Denton Co., Texas, guardianship file for J T Beall et al, minors, filed in March 1876 term, judgment made July 1878. It is not clear from whom Laura and her siblings were inheriting Tarrant Co. land, either from Barns or Cannon legacies.
