1820 Federal Census of Montgomery Co., Tennessee, p. 213: Nathaniel Sanderson. She may be the female born before 1775 in this household, if Nathaniel Sanderson was her son. He moved to Gibson Co., Tennessee, where he died about 1825. The younger male in this household is likely to be Overall Sanderson, since Nathaniel was his guardian. They both moved to Gibson Co., TN.

1830 Federal Census of Gibson Co., Tennessee p. 246: Overall Sanderson. She may be the female in this household aged 60-69 (born 1761/1770). Overall Sanderson was listed as her son in her Feb 1837 will.

1837 Shelby Co., Tennessee. Sanderson, Elizabeth, Probate File 434, will made 1 Feb 1837 (Will Book 1, p. 82), proved Apr 1837. Names children: William, John, James, Jacob, Overall, Jane Cock, Sally Barnes, and Elizabeth Cock. Also grandchildren: Jerusha Anna, Elizabeth [daughters of deceased son Nathaniel], Robert, and William Sanderson (sons of Overall). Executor: Milton Estill. Witnesses: Jared S/L Edwards and E. W.
